23	Section 1. Section 6(1) of the act of July 22, 1974
24	(P.L.598, No.206), known as the Pennsylvania Minority Business
25	Development Authority Act, is amended to read:
26	Section 6. Activities and Powers of the Authority;
27	GeneralThe authority, as a public corporation and

1	governmental instrumentality exercising public powers of the
2	Commonwealth, is hereby granted and shall have and may exercise
3	all powers necessary or appropriate to carry out and effectuate
4	the purposes of this act, including the following powers, in
5	addition to others herein granted:
6	[(1) To have existence for a term of fifty years.]

8	Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>Section 8.1. Minority Business Development Program(a)</u>
10	The Minority Business Development Program is established within
11	the authority to provide minority business enterprises with
12	awards for any of the following:
13	(1) Equity or patient capital.
14	(2) Gap financing.
15	(3) Soft loans, including loans for predevelopment.
16	(b) The authority shall administer the program and issue
17	guidelines to implement this section. The guidelines, at a
18	minimum, shall include the following:
19	(1) An application process for a minority business
20	enterprise to apply for an award under the program.
21	(2) Eligibility requirements for an award under the program.
22	(3) Allowable uses of an award under the program, including
23	any condition that a minority business enterprise must meet.
24	(4) The maximum amount of an award under the program, in
25	accordance with the following:
26	(i) The maximum aggregate amount for loan awards under the
27	program shall not exceed:
28	(A) Except as provided in clause (B), five million dollars
29	<u>(\$5,000,000) per applicant per year.</u>
30	(B) For development projects located in a county of the

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1	first class or a county of the second class, ten million dollars
2	<u>(\$10,000,000) per applicant per year.</u>
3	(ii) The maximum aggregate amount for equity or patient
4	capital awards under the program shall not exceed:
5	(A) Except as provided in clause (B), three million dollars
6	<u>(\$3,000,000) per applicant per year.</u>
7	(B) For development projects located in a county of the
8	first class or a county of the second class, five million
9	<u>dollars (\$5,000,000) per applicant per year.</u>
10	(iii) An applicant may not have more than three development
11	projects financed through the program per year.
12	(5) The interest rates and repayment terms regarding an
13	award under the program.
14	(c) As used in this section, the term "program" means the
15	Minority Business Development Program established under
16	subsection (a).
