AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in vocational education, providing
- for an online career resource center.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1842.1. Online Career Resource Center.--(a) The
- 13 Department of Education shall establish, in consultation with
- 14 the Department of Labor and Industry and the Department of
- 15 Agriculture, a central online clearinghouse which shall at a
- 16 minimum include an online database of the following:
- 17 (1) Postsecondary pathways and options.
- 18 (2) Career and technical education and workforce

- 1 <u>opportunities.</u>
- 2 (3) Career pathways.
- 3 (4) Data and statistics on employment opportunities and
- 4 <u>compensation</u>.
- 5 (5) Statewide and regional articulation agreements.
- 6 (6) Other relevant career resources.
- 7 (b) The online database shall be easily accessible by
- 8 <u>students</u>, <u>parents</u>, <u>educators</u>, <u>school officials and the general</u>
- 9 <u>public. The Department of Education may utilize existing</u>
- 10 resources or clearinghouses available from other agencies to
- 11 <u>compile the clearinghouse information.</u>
- 12 (c) The Department of Education shall explore the
- 13 possibility of Federal or private funding to support the
- 14 <u>clearinghouse</u>.
- 15 (d) The Department of Education, at least annually, shall
- 16 update the online database.
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
