7	Section 1. Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 5539.1. Kidnapping of animals.
10	(a) Offense defined A person commits an offense if the
11	<pre>person:</pre>
12	(1) intentionally, knowingly or recklessly takes, sells
13	or purchases any dog, cat, equine animal, swine or cattle for
14	resale to another, use in a laboratory or for animal
15	fighting; or
16	(2) intentionally, knowingly or recklessly takes or
17	carries away any dog, cat or equine animal without permission
18	for a special or temporary purpose.

- 1 (b) Grading. -- An offense under subsection (a) shall be graded as follows: 2 (1) An offense under subsection (a) (1) is a felony of 3 4 the third degree and a second or subsequent offense under subsection (a) (1) is a felony of the second degree. 5 6 (2) An offense under subsection (a) (2) is a misdemeanor of the third degree and a second or subsequent offense under 7 subsection (a) (2) is a misdemeanor of the second degree. 8
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
