AN ACT

Amending the act of May 22, 1951 (P.L.317, No.69), entitled "An act relating to the practice of professional nursing; providing for the licensing of nurses and for the revocation and suspension of such licenses, subject to appeal, and for 3 4 their reinstatement; providing for the renewal of such 5 licenses; regulating nursing in general; prescribing 7 penalties and repealing certain laws," further providing for continuing nursing education. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Section 12.1(b) of the act of May 22, 1951 12 (P.L.317, No.69), known as The Professional Nursing Law, is amended to read: 13 14 Section 12.1. Continuing Nursing Education. -- * * * 15 Beginning with the license period designated by 16 regulation, licensees shall be required to attend and complete 17 thirty (30) hours of mandatory continuing education during each two-year license period. Nationally certified education courses 18 shall be considered as creditable, in addition to any other 19

- 1 courses the board deems creditable toward meeting the
- 2 requirements for continuing education. Continuing education in
- 3 older adult abuse recognition and reporting is required as
- 4 follows:
- 5 (1) A registered nurse or licensed practical nurse seeking
- 6 <u>licensure renewal shall complete one (1) hour of the Board-</u>
- 7 approved mandatory thirty (30) hours of continuing education
- 8 <u>during the biennial period immediately preceding the application</u>
- 9 for renewal in accordance with this section in older adult abuse
- 10 recognition and reporting, including, but not limited to,
- 11 recognition of the signs of older adult abuse and the reporting
- 12 <u>requirements for suspected older adult abuse in this</u>
- 13 <u>Commonwealth. Continuing education under this paragraph shall be</u>
- 14 approved by the department. The following apply:
- 15 <u>(i) The Board may not renew a license of a registered nurse</u>
- 16 or licensed practical nurse who fails to verify compliance with
- 17 this requirement. A registered nurse or licensed practical nurse
- 18 whose license is not renewed by the expiration date of the
- 19 biennial period may not engage in the practice of professional
- 20 nursing until the older adult abuse continuing education
- 21 requirement is satisfied and the license has been renewed,
- 22 reinstated or reactivated.
- 23 (ii) An applicant applying for initial licensure in this
- 24 Commonwealth shall not be required to meet the continuing
- 25 education requirement in this subsection on the first renewal
- 26 immediately following licensure, except for mandatory continuing
- 27 education in older adult abuse recognition and reporting
- 28 required under this subsection.
- 29 (iii) The Board may perform audits on registered nurses or
- 30 licensed practical nurses to determine compliance with the older

- 1 <u>adult abuse continuing education requirements. A registered</u>
- 2 nurse or licensed practical nurse shall retain documentation of
- 3 the registered nurse's or licensed practical nurse's completion
- 4 of older adult abuse continuing education for at least five (5)
- 5 years. A registered nurse or licensed practical nurse shall
- 6 comply with a request for submission of documents verifying the
- 7 registered nurse's or licensed practical nurse's completion of
- 8 <u>older adult abuse continuing education. For attendance at</u>
- 9 continuing education programs or courses, the registered nurse
- 10 or licensed practical nurse shall retain the certificate of
- 11 attendance provided by the program or course provider and submit
- 12 the same to the Board upon request.
- 13 (iv) A registered nurse or licensed practical nurse seeking
- 14 to reinstate a lapsed license or reactivate an inactive license
- 15 <u>shall file an application for reinstatement or reactivation and</u>
- 16 submit, or cause to be submitted, documentation to demonstrate
- 17 that the licensee completed the hour required in approved older
- 18 adult abuse recognition and reporting within the biennial period
- 19 immediately preceding application.
- 20 (v) A registered nurse or licensed practical nurse seeking
- 21 to reinstate a suspended license shall submit, or cause to be
- 22 submitted, documentation to demonstrate that the registered
- 23 nurse or licensed practical nurse completed the hour in approved
- 24 older adult abuse recognition and reporting within the biennial
- 25 period immediately preceding application for reinstatement.
- 26 (vi) Older adult abuse continuing education hours may not be
- 27 <u>carried over from one biennial renewal period to the next.</u>
- 28 (vii) A registered nurse or licensed practical nurse may
- 29 request a waiver of the older adult abuse continuing education
- 30 requirement because of serious illness, military service or

- 1 <u>other demonstrated hardship. The registered nurse or licensed</u>
- 2 practical nurse shall submit the request and any supporting
- 3 documentation to the Board in writing at least ninety (90) days
- 4 prior to the registered nurse's or licensed practical nurse's
- 5 <u>license expiration date unless an emergency or hardship occurs</u>
- 6 within the ninety-day period. The Board shall grant, deny or
- 7 grant in part the request for waiver.
- 8 (viii) (A) Failure to complete the one-hour continuing
- 9 education requirement on older adult abuse in accordance with
- 10 this subsection shall be subject to the registered nurse or
- 11 <u>licensed practical nurse discipline under section 13(b) in</u>
- 12 <u>accordance with the schedule of civil penalties in 49 Pa. Code §</u>
- 13 <u>43b.18a (relating to schedule of civil penalties-nurses). A</u>
- 14 second or subsequent violation shall subject the registered
- 15 nurse or licensed practical nurse to discipline under section
- 16 14(a)(3).
- 17 (B) A registered nurse or licensed practical nurse who has
- 18 not completed the mandatory hour of older adult abuse continuing
- 19 education shall make up the deficiency within six (6) months of
- 20 receiving notice of the deficiency.
- 21 (C) Notwithstanding any civil penalty assessed under clause
- 22 (A), failure to provide the Board with documentation
- 23 demonstrating the completion of one (1) hour of older adult
- 24 abuse continuing education within six (6) months after receiving
- 25 notice of a deficiency shall subject the registered nurse or
- 26 licensed practical nurse to discipline under section 14(a)(3).
- 27 <u>(D) Failure to comply with an audit request for older adult</u>
- 28 abuse continuing education documentation may subject a
- 29 registered nurse or licensed practical nurse to additional
- 30 discipline under section 14(a)(4)(i).
