AN ACT

- Designating a portion of Pennsylvania Route 44 in Potter County as the Highway to the Stars.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Highway to the Stars.
- 6 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (1) The International Dark Sky Preserve at Cherry
- 9 Springs State Park is an attraction for professional and
- 10 amateur astronomers and photographers, as well as others who
- 11 have an interest in stargazing from one of the darkest places
- 12 in the country.
- 13 (2) The visitor count to Cherry Springs State Park has
- been rising each year, and the ripple effect is being felt by
- 15 regional businesses.
- 16 (3) Pennsylvania Route 44 passes directly through Cherry
- 17 Springs State Park, taking travelers to a publicly accessible
- dark sky viewing field and amphitheater and a separate

- 1 observation area for astronomers, professional photographers
- 2 and others with specialized interests.
- 3 (b) Designation. -- The section of Pennsylvania Route 44 in
- 4 Potter County from U.S. Route 6 to the Lycoming County Line is
- 5 designated the Highway to the Stars.
- 6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the highway to
- 8 traffic in both directions on the highway.
- 9 Section 2. Effective date.
- 10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
