1 2 3	Amending Title 58 (Oil and Gas) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in development, providing for a safety training program.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 58 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	<u>§ 3228. Safety training program.</u>
9	(a) General ruleThe department shall establish a safety
10	training program for individuals desiring to work in the oil and
11	gas industry in this Commonwealth. Program instruction shall
12	prepare an individual for a certification examination which
13	tests knowledge necessary for entry-level work in the oil and
14	gas industry. Program instruction shall include, at a minimum:
15	(1) Oil and gas well site operations.
16	(2) Health and safety issues.
17	(3) Emergency response.
18	(4) Accident prevention and hazard recognition.

1	(5) Worker and operator rights and responsibilities.	
2	(b) CertificationUpon completion of the program	
3	instruction, an individual is eligible to sit for a	
4	certification examination to be administered by the department.	
5	The department shall issue a certificate to an individual who	
6	passes the examination.	
7	(c) Required participationA worker at a permitted well	
8	site must possess a certificate demonstrating successful	
9	completion of the program. The department shall issue a	
10	certificate to a worker with more than one year of experience in	
11	the oil and gas industry if the worker successfully completes an	
12	abbreviated program as determined by the department.	
13	(d) Entry-level workersAn operator shall require that	
14	workers with less than one year of prior experience in the oil	
15	and gas industry wear a green hard hat for one year following	
16	completion of the program.	
17	(e) ReportThe department shall evaluate the program and	
18	annually submit a report to the Governor and the General	
19	Assembly on the following:	
20	(1) The number of individuals who receive program	
21	training.	
22	(2) The number of individuals who are issued	
23	certificates.	
24	(3) Recommendations to improve the program's	
25	effectiveness.	
26	(f) DatabaseThe department shall develop and maintain a	
27	publicly accessible Internet database which lists all certified	
28	workers.	
29	(g) CostsCosts of the program shall be borne by the	
30	individual program participants and shall not be the	
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- 1 <u>responsibility of the Commonwealth.</u>
- (h) Third parties. -- The department may contract with third 2 parties to provide the program. 3 4 (i) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this 5 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise: 6 "Program." The safety and training program, including the 7 examination component, established under subsection (a). 8 "Well site." As defined in section 3216 (relating to well 9 10 site restoration). Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 11
