## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 42 (Judiciary and Judicial Procedure) of the
- 2 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in forfeitures, providing
- for Pennsylvania Game Commission forfeitures.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
- 8 § 6803. Pennsylvania Game Commission forfeitures.
- 9 (a) Motion to return seized property.--If the Pennsylvania
- 10 Game Commission seized the property of an individual who is
- 11 suspected of violating a provision of 34 Pa.C.S. (relating to
- 12 game) and the individual is found not quilty of the violation,
- 13 the individual may file a motion for return of the seized
- 14 property under Rule 588 of the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal
- 15 Procedure before the court of common pleas.
- 16 (b) Court costs.--If the Pennsylvania Game Commission
- 17 opposes the motion and the court grants the motion in favor of
- 18 the individual, the court shall order the Pennsylvania Game

- 1 Commission to pay the individual's court costs directly related
- 2 to the motion.
- 3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
