AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the 4 laws relating thereto, " in terms and courses of study, 5 further providing for fire and emergency evacuation drills. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1517(a) and (a.1) of the act of March 10, 9 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, 10 11 amended November 6, 2017 (P.L.1142, No.55), are amended to read: 12 Section 1517. Fire and Emergency Evacuation Drills.--(a) 13 Except as provided under subsection (a.1), in all school 14 buildings of school entities where fire-escapes, appliances for the extinguishment of fires, or proper and sufficient exits in 15 16 case of fire or panic, either or all, are required by law to be 17 maintained, [fire drills] a fire drill and school security drill_ shall be periodically conducted <u>during alternating months</u>, not 18 19 less than one a month, by the teacher or teachers in charge, under rules and regulations to be promulgated by the chief 20

school administrator under whose supervision such school 1 2 entities are. In such fire drills the pupils and teachers shall 3 be instructed in, and made thoroughly familiar with, the use of the fire-escapes, appliances and exits. The drill shall include 4 the actual use thereof, and the complete removal of the pupils 5 and teachers, in an expeditious and orderly manner, by means of 6 fire-escapes and exits, from the building to a place of safety 7 8 on the ground outside.

9 (a.1) [Within ninety (90) days of the commencement of the 10 school year after the effective date of this subsection and 11 within ninety (90) days of the commencement of each school year 12 thereafter, each school entity may conduct one school security 13 drill per school year in each school building in place of a fire 14 drill required under subsection (a).] All of the following shall 15 apply:

16 (1) The school security drill may be conducted while the 17 school entity is in session and students are present under 18 policies adopted by the chief school administrator.

19 (2) The chief school administrator or a designee shall 20 oversee the instruction and training of students and school 21 employees in the procedures to be used in the school security 22 drill.

(3) The chief school administrator shall notify and request
assistance from the local law enforcement agency and emergency
management agency before conducting the school security drill <u>at</u>
least once during the school year.

(4) The chief school administrator shall provide notice of
the school security drill in advance to parents and legal
guardians of the students attending the school building for
which the school security drill is scheduled.
