AN ACT

- Amending the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), entitled 1 "An act providing for access to public information, for a 2 designated open-records officer in each Commonwealth agency, 3 local agency, judicial agency and legislative agency, for procedure, for appeal of agency determination, for judicial review and for the Office of Open Records; imposing 5 penalties; providing for reporting by State-related 7 institutions; requiring the posting of certain State contract 8 information on the Internet; and making related repeals," in preliminary provisions, further providing for definitions; in 10 procedure, further providing for exceptions for public 11 records; and, in State-related institutions, further 12 providing for definition, for reporting, for contents of 13 report and for copies and posting. 14 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 16 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. The definitions of "State-affiliated entity" and 17 18 "State-related institution" in section 102 of the act of February 14, 2008 (P.L.6, No.3), known as the Right-to-Know Law, 19 20 are amended to read: 21 Section 102. Definitions. 22 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 23 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the

- 3 "State-affiliated entity." A Commonwealth authority or
- 4 Commonwealth entity. The term includes the Pennsylvania Higher
- 5 Education Assistance Agency and any entity established thereby,
- 6 the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board, the Pennsylvania Game
- 7 Commission, the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission, the
- 8 Pennsylvania Housing Finance Agency, the Pennsylvania Municipal
- 9 Retirement Board, the State System of Higher Education, a State-
- 10 <u>related institution and its affiliates</u>, a community college, the
- 11 Pennsylvania Turnpike Commission, the Pennsylvania Public
- 12 Utility Commission, the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment
- 13 Authority, the State Public School Building Authority, the
- 14 Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association and the
- 15 Pennsylvania Higher Educational Facilities Authority. [The term
- 16 does not include a State-related institution.]
- 17 "State-related institution." Includes:
- 18 (1) Temple University, including its graduate schools,
- 19 <u>law school, medical school and continental and international</u>
- 20 branch campuses.
- 21 (2) The University of Pittsburgh, including its graduate
- 22 <u>schools, medical school and branch campuses</u>.
- 23 (3) The Pennsylvania State University, including its
- 24 graduate schools, law school, medical school and branch
- 25 <u>campuses and the Pennsylvania College of Technology</u>.
- 26 (4) Lincoln University, including its graduate schools
- and branch campuses.

- 3 1502, 1503 and 1504 of the act are amended to read:
- 4 Section 708. Exceptions for public records.

- 6 (b) Exceptions.--Except as provided in subsections (c) and
- 7 (d), the following are exempt from access by a requester under
- 8 this act:

- 10 (11) A record that constitutes or reveals a trade secret
- or confidential proprietary information, including research
- 12 <u>and development information of a State-related institution or</u>
- its affiliates.

- 15 (13) Records that would disclose the identity of an
- individual who lawfully makes a donation to an agency or a
- 17 State-related institution and its affiliates unless the
- 18 donation is intended for or restricted to providing
- remuneration or personal tangible benefit to a named public
- official [or], employee of the agency or an officer, director
- 21 or employee of a State-related institution and its
- 22 <u>affiliates</u>, including lists of potential donors compiled by
- an agency to pursue donations, donor profile information or
- 24 personal identifying information relating to a donor.

- unpublished articles, creative works in progress, research-

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- 11 Section 1501. Definition.
- 12 As used in this chapter, "State-related institution" means
- 13 any of the following:
- 14 (1) Temple University, including its graduate schools,
- 15 <u>law school, medical school and continental and international</u>
- 16 <u>branch campuses</u>.
- 17 (2) The University of Pittsburgh, including its graduate
- 18 schools, medical school and branch campuses.
- 19 (3) The Pennsylvania State University, including its
- 20 graduate schools, law school, medical school and branch
- 21 campuses and the Pennsylvania College of Technology.
- 22 (4) Lincoln University, including its graduate schools
- and branch campuses.
- 24 (5) Any associated hospital, medical center, institute,
- facility, subsidiary or subordinate unit of any of the
- institutions enumerated in paragraphs (1), (2), (3) and (4).
- 27 Section 1502. Reporting.
- No later than May 30 of each year, a State-related
- 29 institution and its affiliates shall file with the Governor's
- 30 Office, the General Assembly, the Auditor General and the State

- 1 Library the information set forth in section 1503.
- 2 Section 1503. Contents of report.
- 3 The report required under section 1502 shall include the
- 4 following:
- 5 (1) Except as provided in paragraph (4), all information
- 6 required by Form 990 or an equivalent form of the United
- 7 States Department of the Treasury, Internal Revenue Service,
- 8 entitled the Return of Organization Exempt From Income Tax,
- 9 regardless of whether the State-related institution, and any
- of its affiliates, is required to file the form by the
- 11 Federal Government.
- 12 (2) The salaries of all officers and directors of the
- 13 State-related institution and its affiliates.
- 14 (3) The highest 25 salaries paid to employees of the
- institution and its affiliates that are not included under
- paragraph (2).
- 17 (4) The report shall not include information relating to
- 18 individual donors.
- 19 Section 1504. Copies and posting.
- 20 A State-related institution and its affiliates shall
- 21 maintain, for at least seven years, a copy of the report in the
- 22 institution's or affiliate's library and shall provide free
- 23 access to the report on the institution's or affiliate's
- 24 Internet website.
- 25 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
