AN ACT

Amending the act of October 17, 2008 (P.L.1645, No.132), entitled "An act providing for the regulation of home 2 improvement contracts and for the registration of certain 3 contractors; prohibiting certain acts; and providing for 4 penalties," providing for persons ineligible to work for 5 registered contractors. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. The act of October 17, 2008 (P.L.1645, No.132), 10 known as the Home Improvement Consumer Protection Act, is 11 amended by adding a section to read: 12 Section 8.1. Persons ineligible to work for registered 13 contractors. 14 A person who has been convicted of a crime relating to the 15 performance of the person's home improvement work shall be 16 ineligible to work for a contractor registered under this act. A 17 contractor who submits an application for a certificate for a 18 home improvement contractor or a renewal of that 19 certificate shall certify to the bureau that the contractor does not have a person who is ineligible to work under this section 20

- 1 on the contractor's payroll as an employee or a subcontractor
- 2 upon the submission of the application in a form and manner
- 3 <u>determined by the bureau.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
