6	SECTION 2. SECTION 1704 OF TITLE 23 IS REPEALED:
7	[§ 1704. Marriage between persons of the same sex.
8	It is hereby declared to be the strong and longstanding
9	public policy of this Commonwealth that marriage shall be
10	between one man and one woman. A marriage between persons of the
11	same sex which was entered into in another state or foreign
12	jurisdiction, even if valid where entered into, shall be void in
13	this Commonwealth.]
