12	(2) To hold information, strategy and negotiation
13	sessions related to the negotiation or arbitration of a
14	collective bargaining agreement or, in the absence of a
15	collective bargaining unit, related to labor relations and
16	arbitration. This paragraph does not apply to negotiation
17	sessions related to collective bargaining agreements between
18	an employee organization and employer as defined in the act

1	of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School	_
