AN ACT

1 Amending the act of December 22, 2005 (P.L.474, No.94), entitled
2 "An act providing for the notification of residents whose
3 personal information data was or may have been disclosed due
4 to a security system breach; and imposing penalties," further
5 providing for definitions.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. The definition of "personal information" in
9 section 2 of the act of December 22, 2005 (P.L.474, No.94),
10 known as the Breach of Personal Information Notification Act, is
11 amended and the section is amended by adding a definition to
12 read:

13 Section 2. Definitions.

14 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
15 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
16 context clearly indicates otherwise:

18 "Digital wallet." An electronic payment system that allows
19 an individual to store funds and make electronic transactions.

1 * * *

2 "Personal information."

3 (1) An individual's first name or first initial and last
4 name in combination with and linked to any one or more of the
5 following data elements when the data elements are not
6 encrypted or redacted:

7 (i) Social Security number.

8 (ii) Driver's license number or a State
9 identification card number issued in lieu of a driver's
10 license.

11 (iii) Financial account number, credit or debit card
12 number, in combination with any required security code,
13 access code or password that would permit access to an
14 individual's financial account.

15 (iv) Digital wallet.

16 (2) The term does not include publicly available
17 information that is lawfully made available to the general
18 public from Federal, State or local government records.

19 * * *

20 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
