1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in municipal police education and training, further providing for powers and duties of commission; establishing the Police Department Grant Program; and repealing provisions in Title 4 relating to transfers from State Gaming Fund.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. Section 2164 of Title 53 of the Pennsylvania
10	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
11	§ 2164. Powers and duties of commission.
12	The powers and duties of the commission shall be as follows:
13	* * *
14	(17) To require minimum standards for training police
15	officers on domestic violence. The training shall include
16	standards for assessing the lethality risk of domestic
17	violence incidents. As used in this paragraph, the term
18	"police officer" also includes a member of the Pennsylvania
19	State Police.

1	Section 2. Title 53 is amended by adding a section to read:
2	<u>§ 2172. Police Department Grant Program.</u>
3	(a) EstablishmentThe Police Department Grant Program is
4	established and shall be administered by the center.
5	(b) Purpose of grantsThe center shall award grants to
6	eligible police departments. Grant funds may be used for the
7	following:
8	(1) Vehicle acquisition.
9	(2) Cameras, including cameras to be placed in vehicles.
10	(3) Speed timing devices.
11	<u>(4)</u> Uniforms.
12	(5) Police and emergency equipment.
13	(6) Training, including domestic violence training.
14	(7) Personnel costs.
15	(8) Community law enforcement efforts.
16	<u>(c) Pennsylvania State PoliceThe Pennsylvania State</u>
17	Police shall be eligible for a grant under this section for
18	domestic violence training in order to fund the training
19	required under section 2164(17) (relating to powers and duties
20	<u>of commission).</u>
21	(d) Application and review
22	(1) The center shall notify police departments of the
23	availability of the program by July 1 for fiscal years
24	<u>beginning after June 30, 2016.</u>
25	(2) The center shall develop and distribute a uniform
26	application for police departments to submit for grants under
27	the program. The center shall provide the application form
28	and accompanying instructions to police departments annually
29	by September 1.
30	(3) To be considered, an application must be submitted

1	to the center no later than November 30 of each fiscal year.
2	The center shall approve or disapprove an application within
3	60 days of the application being filed.
4	(4) The center shall review applications submitted for
5	grants under the program and shall approve them if they meet
6	the requirements of paragraph (5) and the police department
7	agrees to the terms and conditions for the grant as
8	determined by the center. A police department must submit a
9	signed agreement to the center prior to the release of grant
10	funds to the police department.
11	(5) Grants shall be awarded based upon the demonstrated
12	need of the police department requesting the grant.
13	(e) Conditions
14	(1) A police department that fails to return a signed
15	agreement for the preceding fiscal year is ineligible for
16	grant funding in the current fiscal year unless the police
17	department provides to the center a reasonable written
18	explanation as to why the police department failed to claim
19	its grant.
20	(2) A police department that fails to demonstrate that
21	it complied with all the terms of its agreement for the
22	preceding fiscal year is ineligible for grant funding in the
23	current fiscal year.
24	(f) Funding
25	(1) Annually, the sum of \$2,000,000 shall be transferred
26	from the State Gaming Fund to the department for the purpose
27	of issuing grants.
28	(2) No money from the transfer under paragraph (1) may
29	be used for expenses or costs incurred by the department for
30	the administration of the program.

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1	(g) ReportWithin six months of receiving a grant, a
2	police department shall submit a report to the center. The
3	report shall document the use of the grant funds by the police
4	<u>department.</u>
5	(h) GuidelinesThe department shall adopt guidelines
6	necessary to implement and administer the provisions of this
7	section.
8	(i) ApplicabilityThis section shall apply to fiscal years
9	<u>beginning on or after July 1, 2016.</u>
10	(j) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following
11	words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
12	subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
13	"Center." The Center for Local Government Services within
14	the Department of Community and Economic Development of the
15	Commonwealth.
16	"Department." The Department of Community and Economic
17	Development of the Commonwealth.
18	"Grant." A grant awarded to a police department in
19	accordance with this section.
20	"Program." The Police Department Grant Program established
21	<u>under this section.</u>
22	Section 3. Repeals are as follows:
23	(1) The General Assembly declares that the repeal under
24	paragraph (2) is necessary to effectuate the addition of 53
25	Pa.C.S. § 2172.
26	(2) The provisions of 4 Pa.C.S. § 1408(c) are repealed.
27	Section 4. This act shall take effect as follows:
