- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for 1 2 definitions; in fees, providing for recreational trailers and 3 for special procedures for trailer registration; and, in 5 size, weight and load, further providing for registered gross weight. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. The definition of "recreational trailer" in 10 section 102 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 11 Statutes is amended to read: 12 § 102. Definitions. Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent 13 14 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when 15

- 2 (1) to provide temporary living quarters for

- 8 Section 2. Title 75 is amended by adding sections to read:
- 9 § 1920.1. Recreational trailers.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- The annual fee for registration of a
- 11 recreational trailer shall be determined by its registered gross
- 12 weight according to the following table:
- 13 <u>Registered Gross</u>
- 14 <u>Weight in Pounds</u> <u>Fee</u>
- 15 <u>8,000 or less</u> <u>\$12</u>
- 16 <u>8,001 13,000</u> <u>35</u>
- 17 13,001 or more 90
- 18 (b) Optional five-year registration. -- A recreational trailer
- 19 with a registered gross weight of 13,000 pounds or less may be
- 20 registered for a period of five years upon payment by the
- 21 registrant of the applicable fee for such period.
- 22 (c) Optional permanent registration. -- The following apply:
- 23 (1) A recreational trailer with a registered gross
- 24 weight of 13,001 or more pounds may be registered for a one-
- 25 time fee of \$425 in lieu of the annual fee at the option of
- the registrant.
- 27 (2) A permanent registration of a recreational trailer
- 28 under this section may be transferred to another recreational
- trailer one time upon payment of the fee under section 1927
- 30 (relating to transfer of registration).

- 2 (a) General rule. -- Application for the registration of a
- 3 trailer, including a recreational trailer, shall be made upon an
- 4 appropriate form furnished by the department. The form shall
- 5 <u>contain the definition of recreational trailer as set forth</u>
- 6 <u>under section 102</u> (relating to definitions), and the applicant
- 7 must certify, if applicable, that the trailer meets the
- 8 definition.
- 9 (b) Penalty. -- An applicant who falsely certifies that a
- 10 trailer is a recreational trailer on an application for a
- 11 trailer registration is subject to the penalty under 18 Pa.C.S.
- 12 § 4904(b) (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).
- 13 Section 3. Section 4942(c) of Title 75 is amended to read:
- 14 § 4942. Registered gross weight.
- 15 * * *
- 16 (c) Combination. -- No combination containing a trailer having
- 17 a gross weight or registered gross weight in excess of 10,000
- 18 pounds shall be operated with a gross weight in excess of the
- 19 registered gross weight of the truck or truck tractor for a
- 20 combination. This subsection shall not apply to a combination of
- 21 <u>vehicles consisting of a motor vehicle towing a recreational</u>
- 22 trailer as long as the combination weight does not exceed the
- 23 gross combination weight rating.
- 24 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
