- penalties," providing for prohibition of certain fee charges. 6

- hereby enacts as follows: 8
- 9 Section 1. The act of December 17, 1968 (P.L.1224, No.387),
- known as the Unfair Trade Practices and Consumer Protection Law, 10
- 11 is amended by adding a section to read:
- 12 Section 3.2. Prohibition of certain fee charges. -- (a)
- Subject to Federal law and regulation, a person may not charge a 13
- consumer an additional rate or fee or a differential in the rate 14
- 15 or fee associated with payment on an account when the consumer
- chooses to pay by the United States mail or receive a paper 16
- 17 billing statement.
- 18 (b) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit a
- 19 person from offering consumers a credit or other incentive to

- 1 elect a specific payment or billing option.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
