## AN ACT

1 2	Amending the act of May 29, 2012 (P.L.549, No.54), entitled "An act establishing a Statewide stroke system of care by
3	recognizing primary stroke centers and directing the creation
4	of emergency medical services training and transport
5	protocols; and providing for the powers and duties of the
6	Department of Health," further providing for short title, for
7 8	definitions, for recognition of centers, for emergency medical services and for biennial report.

9	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10	hereby enacts as follows:
11	Section 1. Section 1 of the act of May 29, 2012 (P.L.549,
12	No.54), known as the Primary Stroke Center Recognition Act, is
13	amended to read:
14	Section 1. Short title.
15	This act shall be known and may be cited as the [Primary
16	Stroke Center Recognition] Stroke System of Care Act.
17	Section 2. Section 2 of the act is amended by adding
18	definitions to read:
19	Section 2. Definitions.
20	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall

1	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
2	context clearly indicates otherwise:
3	"Acute stroke-ready hospital." A hospital which is
4	designated as an acute stroke-ready hospital by the joint
5	commission or a nongovernmental organization that has been
6	authorized by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services
7	(CMS) to conduct hospital surveys to ensure compliance with the
8	CMS Conditions of Participation.
9	"Comprehensive stroke center." A facility which is
10	designated as a comprehensive stroke center by the joint
11	commission or a nongovernmental organization that has been
12	authorized by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services
13	(CMS) to conduct hospital surveys to ensure compliance with the
14	CMS Conditions of Participation.

16	"Primary stroke center." A facility which is designated as a
17	primary stroke center by the joint commission or a
18	nongovernmental organization that has been authorized by the
19	<u>Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to conduct</u>
20	hospital surveys to ensure compliance with the CMS Conditions of
21	Participation.
22	Section 3. Sections 3, $4(a)$ and $(c)$ and $5(b)(1)$ and $(2)$ of
23	the act are amended to read:
24	Section 3. Recognition of centers.
25	(a) General ruleUpon application by a licensed acute care
26	hospital, the department shall recognize the hospital as a
27	<u>comprehensive stroke center,</u> primary stroke center <u>or acute</u>
28	stroke-ready hospital if the hospital is certified as a
29	<u>comprehensive stroke center,</u> primary stroke center <u>or acute</u>
30	stroke-ready hospital by the joint commission or another
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nationally recognized accrediting organization that provides
 certification for stroke care. The designation shall last as
 long as the hospital remains certified [as a primary stroke
 center].

5 (b) Suspension or revocation of recognition.--The department 6 may suspend or revoke [primary stroke center] recognition <u>under</u> 7 <u>subsection (a)</u> if the department determines that the hospital is 8 not in compliance with provisions of this act requiring 9 accreditation as a <u>comprehensive stroke center</u>, primary stroke 10 center <u>or acute stroke-ready hospital</u>.

11 Section 4. Emergency medical services.

12 (a) List of [primary] <u>all</u> stroke centers.--The department 13 shall:

14 (1) Make available a list of [accredited] <u>certified</u>
 15 <u>comprehensive stroke centers</u>, primary stroke centers <u>and</u>
 16 <u>acute stroke-ready hospitals</u> to each emergency medical
 17 services agency medical director in this Commonwealth.

18 (2) Maintain a copy of the list of <u>certified</u>
 19 <u>comprehensive stroke centers</u>, primary stroke centers <u>and</u>
 20 <u>acute stroke-ready hospitals</u> in the office designated with
 21 the department to oversee emergency medical services.

22 (3) Post a list of <u>certified comprehensive stroke</u>
 23 <u>centers</u>, primary stroke centers <u>and acute stroke-ready</u>
 24 <u>hospitals</u> on the department's Internet website.

(c) Protocols.--The department shall establish protocols
that are related to prehospital assessment, treatment and
transport of stroke patients by licensed emergency medical
services providers[.] that will allow the patient to receive the
appropriate care at a certified stroke center in the shortest

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1	amount of time. The protocols shall include plans for triage and
2	transport of acute stroke patients to the closest [primary]
3	certified stroke center or a facility that can provide
4	appropriate treatment if the [primary] <u>certified</u> stroke center
5	is not within a specified time frame from onset of symptoms.

7	Section 5. Biennial report.

9	(b) ContentsThe report shall include:
10	(1) The number, location and county of [accredited]
11	certified comprehensive stroke centers, primary stroke
12	centers and acute stroke-ready hospitals in this
13	Commonwealth.
14	(2) Changes in the number and/or locations of <u>certified</u>
15	comprehensive stroke centers, primary stroke centers and
16	acute stroke-ready hospitals since the last report.

18	Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
