AN ACT

Amending the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, No.86), entitled "An act to promote the public health and safety by providing for 2 examination, licensing and granting of permits for those who 3 desire to engage in the profession of cosmetology; defining 4 cosmetology, and regulating cosmetology salons, schools, 5 students, apprentices, teachers, managers, manicurists and 6 cosmetologists; conferring powers and duties upon the Commissioner of Professional and Occupational Affairs of the 8 Department of State; providing for appeals to certain courts 9 by applicants and licensees; and providing penalties," 10 further providing for regulations by board. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 11 of the act of May 3, 1933 (P.L.242, 15 No.86), referred to as the Cosmetology Law, is amended to read: 16 Section 11. Regulations by Board .-- (a) The board after at 17 least one public hearing shall prescribe reasonable regulations 18 for its conduct, and for the examination and licensing of 19 applicants to practice or teach cosmetology, for temporary 20 licenses to be issued by the department, and generally for the conduct of persons, copartnerships, associations or corporations 21

- 1 affected by this act.
- 2 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law or regulation
- 3 to the contrary:
- 4 (1) The board shall not have the authority to require any
- 5 <u>minimum floor space or impose any floor space limitations on</u>
- 6 <u>salons as a condition of licensure.</u>
- 7 (2) An applicant for a salon license may submit a sketch
- 8 plan to the board showing the layout of the salon, including the
- 9 position of the doors, windows, partitions, shampoo basins,
- 10 lavatories, adjustable chairs and other floor equipment, prior
- 11 to the commencement of construction. Following a review of the
- 12 <u>sketch plan</u>, the board shall inform the applicant whether the
- 13 sketch plan is in compliance with facility requirements of this
- 14 act and 49 Pa. Code Ch. 7 (relating to State Board of
- 15 <u>Cosmetology</u>).
- 16 Section 2. The provisions of 49 Pa. Code § 7.76 are
- 17 abrogated. The provisions of 49 Pa. Code § 7.51 are abrogated
- 18 insofar as they are inconsistent with the amendment of section
- 19 11 of the act.
- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
