## AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 12 (Commerce and Trade) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in goods and services installment
- sales, further providing for prohibited activities and
- 4 provisions.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 6305 of Title 12 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 6305. Prohibited activities and provisions.
- 10 \* \* \*
- 11 (c) Financing of dogs or cats. -- A seller or holder may not
- 12 enter into a closed-end credit agreement or an open-end credit
- 13 agreement with a buyer for the purchase of a dog or cat. Subject
- 14 to the penalties imposed under Subchapter E (relating to
- 15 <u>enforcement and penalties</u>), a seller or holder may not collect,
- 16 receive or retain any fees relating to an agreement prohibited
- 17 <u>under this subsection. A buyer who receives financing to</u>
- 18 purchase a dog or cat and who obtains physical custody or

- 1 possession of the dog or cat shall obtain legal ownership of the
- 2 dog or cat at the time of taking physical custody or possession.
- 3 This subsection shall not apply to a closed-end credit agreement\_
- 4 <u>or an open-end credit agreement entered into before the</u>
- 5 effective date of this subsection.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
