AN ACT

Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in disabled veterans' real estate tax 2 exemption, further providing for duty of commission by 3 removing a rebuttable presumption. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 8904(1) of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 8904. Duty of commission. 10 The commission shall: Fix uniform and equitable standards for determining 11 12 the need for exemption from the payment of real estate taxes 13 granted by this act. [In fixing such uniform and equitable 14 standards, the commission shall apply a rebuttable 15 presumption that an applicant with annual income of \$75,000 or less has a need for the exemption. Beginning on January 1, 16 17 2009, and every two years thereafter, the commission shall

- adjust the annual income level qualifying for the rebuttable
- 2 presumption of need by an amount equal to the change in the
- 3 Consumer Price Index in the preceding two years. The
- 4 commission shall publish the adjusted annual income level
- qualifying for the rebuttable presumption of need as a notice
- in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.]

- 8 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
