## AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in lighting equipment, further providing for use 2 and display of illuminated signs. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 4307(c.1) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania 6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: § 4307. Use and display of illuminated signs. 8 9 \* \* \* 10 Transportation network company driver. --(c.1)11 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law or 12 regulation to the contrary, but subject to 53 Pa.C.S. § 57A01 (relating to definitions), a [Transportation Network Company 13 Driver] transportation network company driver may display an 14 15 illuminated sign provided by a [Transportation Network 16 Company] transportation network company within the interior 17 of [his or her] the driver's vehicle so long as [such] the sign is approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility 18 19 Commission or the Philadelphia Parking Authority, as

- 1 applicable. The [Transportation Network Company shall]
- 2 <u>transportation network company must</u> file the illuminated sign
- 3 with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission for review
- 4 and approval. If the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission
- 5 does not approve the illuminated sign, the Philadelphia
- 6 Parking Authority may approve the illuminated sign within
- 7 their jurisdiction, after the [Transportation Network
- 8 Company] <u>transportation network company</u> files the illuminated
- 9 sign with the Philadelphia Parking Authority for review and
- 10 approval. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission and the
- 11 Philadelphia Parking Authority shall each have 15 business
- days to review the illuminated sign, as applicable.
- 13 (2) An illuminated sign authorized under paragraph (1)
- 14 <u>may not use blue illumination or substantially mimic lights</u>
- 15 <u>authorized on vehicles under section 4572(a) (relating to</u>
- visual signals on authorized vehicles).

- 18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
