## AN ACT

Amending Title 61 (Prisons and Parole) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, in visitation, providing for personal 2 visitation; and making an editorial change. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Subchapter A heading of Chapter 35 and section 3503 of Title 61 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: 8 9 SUBCHAPTER A 10 [(Reserved)] PERSONAL VISITATION [(Reserved).] <u>Visitation rights.</u> 11 § 3503. 12 (a) Personal visits. -- Except as provided under this title, the following shall apply to visitation within a correctional 13 14 institution: 15 (1) The correctional institution shall permit each 16 inmate to meet with visitors in person at least twice per 17 week.

- 1 (2) The correctional institution shall permit at least
- 2 <u>three individuals to attend each visit provided under</u>
- 3 <u>paragraph (1).</u>
- 4 (3) The correctional institution shall permit the inmate
- 5 <u>to meet with a visitor under paragraph (1) for no less than</u>
- 6 <u>one hour.</u>
- 7 (b) Video visitation. -- Subsection (a) may not be construed
- 8 to limit the use of video visitation, which shall be permitted
- 9 in addition to the two visits per week provided under subsection
- 10 <u>(a)</u>.
- 11 (c) Exceptions. -- This section shall not apply:
- 12 (1) during a lockdown of the correctional institution
- due to a health or safety emergency; or
- 14 (2) to an inmate who is not eligible to receive
- visitation due to the inmate's disciplinary status.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
