Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in game or wildlife protection, providing for unlawful release of certain balloons. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 34 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 7 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: § 2168. Unlawful release of certain balloons. 8 9 (a) General rule. -- It shall be unlawful for any person to 10 knowingly release or cause to be released into the atmosphere, 11 within a one-hour period, 50 or more balloons which are: 12 (1) Made of a nonbiodegradable or nonphotodegradable 13 material or any material which requires more than five 14 minutes' contact with air or water to degrade. 15 (2) Inflated with a substance which is lighter than air. 16 (b) Civil penalty. -- Any person who violates this section 17 shall be liable for a civil penalty not to exceed \$5 per balloon

- 3 (c) Exceptions. -- The provisions of this section shall not
- 4 apply to:
- 5 (1) balloons released by or on behalf of any agency of
- 6 <u>the Commonwealth or the United States or under a contract</u>
- 7 with the Commonwealth, the United States or any other state,
- 8 <u>territory or government for scientific or meteorological</u>
- 9 <u>purposes; or</u>
- 10 (2) hot air balloons that are recovered after launch.
- 11 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
