AN ACT

- Designating a bridge, identified as Bridge Key 56737, carrying Pennsylvania Route 74 over the Little Conewago Creek in Dover
- 3 Township, York County, as the Corporal William E. Heilman
- 4 Memorial Bridge.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Corporal William E. Heilman Memorial Bridge.
- 8 (a) Findings. -- The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (1) William Emory Heilman was born September 11, 1947,
- in York County.
- 12 (2) Corporal Heilman entered the service of the United
- 13 States Marine Corps on May 26, 1966, during the Vietnam War.
- 14 (3) Corporal Heilman served in the Third Marine
- 15 Amphibious Force, H&S Company.
- 16 (4) Corporal Heilman served in Vietnam for eight months
- 17 until he was struck by an artillery rocket mortar on May 5,
- 18 1968.
- 19 (5) Corporal Heilman passed away on May 5, 1968, in

- 1 South Vietnam, Quang Nam Province.
- 2 (6) For his valiant service, Corporal Heilman was
- 3 awarded the Purple Heart, Combat Action Ribbon, National
- 4 Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Vietnam
- 5 Service Medal, Marine Corps Presidential Unit Citation,
- 6 Vietnam Gallantry Cross, Marine Corps Good Conduct Medal and
- 7 Marine Corps Expeditionary Medal.
- 8 (b) Designation. -- The bridge, identified as Bridge Key
- 9 56737, carrying Pennsylvania Route 74 over the Little Conewago
- 10 Creek in Dover Township, York County, is designated the Corporal
- 11 William E. Heilman Memorial Bridge.
- 12 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 13 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 14 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 15 Section 2. Effective date.
- 16 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
