AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Requiring certain research facilities to offer retired animals for adoption; and providing for civil immunity under certain circumstances and for enforcement by Department of Agriculture.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Short title.
8	This act shall be known and may be cited as the Retired
9	Animal Adoption Act.
10	Section 2. Definitions.
11	The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
12	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
13	context clearly indicates otherwise:
14	"Animal rescue organization." A nonprofit organization whose
15	purpose is rescuing animals in need and finding permanent
16	adoptive homes for the animals.
17	"Animal shelter." A nonprofit organization that provides

housing and care for animals, directly or through third-party
 agreements, with the purpose of finding permanent homes for
 these animals through an adoptive process.

"Private placement." An arrangement between a research 4 facility and an individual seeking to adopt a retired animal. 5 "Research facility." A higher education research facility 6 7 that receives public money, including tax-exempt status, or a 8 facility that provides research in collaboration with a higher education facility and any other research facility that conducts 9 10 experiments on dogs or cats for science, testing, education or 11 research purposes.

12 "Retired animal." A cat or dog that has been previously used 13 for science, testing, education or research purposes and is no 14 longer required by the facility and has no substantial medical 15 condition or safety consideration preventing successful

16 integration into a family home.

17 Section 3. Duties of research facilities.

(a) Offer of retired animals for adoption.--A research
facility, or employee or student thereof, that confines and uses
dogs and cats for research, education, testing or scientific
purposes, instead of euthanizing a retired animal, shall:

(1) offer the retired animal to an animal rescueorganization or animal shelter for adoption; or

24 (2) offer the retired animal for adoption through25 private placement.

(b) Agreement required.--A research facility that is required to offer a retired animal to an animal rescue organization under this section shall enter into an agreement with an animal rescue organization or animal shelter for implementation of this section.

1 Section 4. Civil immunity.

A research facility that provides a retired animal to a
rescue organization under this section shall be immune from
civil liability that otherwise might result from its actions,
provided that the research facility acts in good faith.
Section 5. Enforcement.
The Department of Agriculture shall enforce the provisions of
this act.
Section 6. Effective date.
This act shall take effect in 60 days.
