Notice to condemnee. 8 9 10 (c) Contents. -- The notice to be given the condemnee shall 11 state: 12 13 (13) A statement that, if the condemnee wishes to 14 challenge the power or the right of the condemnor to 15 appropriate the condemned property, the sufficiency of the 16 security, the procedure followed by the condemnor or the 17 declaration of taking, the condemnee must file preliminary 18 objections within [30] 90 days after being served with notice
