17	provided for in subparagraph (i) shall be the same as for
18	a similar service at the discretion of the prothonotary.
19	(iii) The prothonotary shall not be required to
20	perform any service until the requisite fee is paid.
21	(iv) Beginning on January 1, 2018, and each January
22	1 thereafter, the prothonotary may, with the approval of
23	the president judge, periodically increase any fee or
24	charge imposed as of the effective date of this
25	paragraph. However, no such fee or charge may be
26	increased more than once in any three-year period, and
27	the amount of any increase may not be greater than the
28	percentage of increase in the Consumer Price Index for
29	Urban Workers for the immediate three years preceding the
30	last increase in the fee or charge.
