AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 26, 1978 (P.L.1375, No.325), 1 entitled "An act providing for the regulation and safety of dams and reservoirs, water obstructions and encroachments; consolidating and clarifying the programs of the Department of Environmental Resources and Navigation Commission for the 5 Delaware River; establishing penalties and repealing certain 6 acts," further providing for definitions; and providing for 7 permit not required for certain maintenance projects. 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. Section 3 of the act of November 26, 1978
- 12 (P.L.1375, No.325), known as the Dam Safety and Encroachments
- 13 Act, is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 14 Section 3. Definitions.
- 15 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 16 have, unless the context clearly indicates otherwise, the
- 17 meanings given to them in this section:
- 18 * * *
- 19 <u>"Flood-related hazard."</u> Flood debris or similar obstruction
- 20 which may present a substantial potential risk to life or

- 1 property or may create additional problems in the event of
- 2 flooding.
- 3 * * *
- 4 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
- 5 <u>Section 6.1. Permit not required for certain maintenance</u>
- 6 <u>projects.</u>
- 7 The department may not require a permit for the removal of
- 8 <u>flood-related hazards or related stream clearing activities that</u>
- 9 are deemed to be an emergency by State or county authorities.
- 10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
