AN ACT

- Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in educational gratuity program,
- further providing for eligibility and qualification

- 7 Section 1. Section 8703(a) of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 \S 8703. Eligibility and qualification requirements.
- 10 (a) Eligibility standards. -- The following requirements shall
- 11 be used to determine the eligibility of applicants for
- 12 educational gratuity payments. The applicant shall be:
- 13 (1) Not less than 16 years of age nor more than 23 years
- of age.
- 15 (2) The child of an eligible disabled or deceased
- 16 veteran.
- 17 (3) A resident of this Commonwealth for a period of

- 1 [five years] one year immediately preceding the date the
- 2 application was filed.

- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
