## AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 9, 1976 (P.L.817, No.143), entitled "An 1 act relating to mental health procedures; providing for the 2 treatment and rights of mentally disabled persons, for voluntary and involuntary examination and treatment and for determinations affecting those charged with crime or under 5 sentence," in general provisions, further providing for 6 rights and remedies of persons in treatment. 7 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 113 of the act of July 9, 1976 (P.L.817, No.143), known as the Mental Health Procedures Act, is amended 11 12 to read: 13 Section 113. - 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
