- 1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in school finances, establishing the
- 6 Bridging the Digital Divide in Schools Grant Program.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 618. Bridging the Digital Divide in Schools Grant
- 13 Program. -- (a) The Bridging the Digital Divide in Schools Grant
- 14 Program is established in the department for the purpose of
- 15 allocating grant money to school entities to provide or expand
- 16 access to technology and technological equipment for students
- 17 who do not have the means to purchase technology and
- 18 technological equipment or who do not have access to the
- 19 Internet at home.
- 20 (b) A grant received by a school entity shall be used for

- 1 the purchase of, or for reimbursement of the school entity's
- 2 purchase of, technology and technological equipment that can be
- 3 <u>used by the school entity's students in school or at home.</u>
- 4 (c) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 5 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 6 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 7 <u>"School entity." A school district, joint school district,</u>
- 8 <u>intermediate unit</u>, charter school or area career and technical
- 9 <u>school.</u>
- 10 "Technology and technological equipment." The term includes,
- 11 but is not limited to, laptops, tablets, hot spot access devices
- 12 and other electronic mobile devices.
- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
