AN ACT

1 Designating a bridge on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 286
 2 over Two Lick Creek, at the east end of the Borough of
 3 Clymer, Indiana County, as the LCpl. Joshua T. Twigg Memorial
 4 Bridge.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
 6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. LCpl. Joshua T. Twigg Memorial Bridge.

8 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
 9 follows:

10 (1) Lance Corporal Joshua T. Twigg was born on October
 11 1, 1988, in Indiana, Pennsylvania, and grew up in Clymer
 12 where he attended Penns Manor High School.

13 (2) Lance Corporal Twigg served his country honorably
 14 with the United States Marine Corps 2nd Battalion, 9th Marine
 15 Regiment, Regimental Combat Team 7.

16 (3) On September 2, 2010, Lance Corporal Twigg was

1 killed in action in Helmand Province, Afghanistan.

2 (b) Designation.--The bridge located on Pennsylvania Route
3 286 over Two Lick Creek, at the east end of the Borough of
4 Clymer, Indiana County, is designated the LCpl. Joshua T. Twigg
5 Memorial Bridge.

6 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
7 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
8 traffic in both directions on the bridge.

9 Section 2. Effective date.

10 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
