AN ACT

- Amending the act of June 29, 1953 (P.L.304, No.66), entitled "An 1 act providing for the administration of a statewide system of 2 vital statistics; prescribing the functions of the State 3 Department of Health, the State Advisory Health Board and local registrars; imposing duties upon coroners, prothonotaries, clerks of orphans' court, physicians, 6 midwives and other persons; requiring reports and 7 certificates for the registration of vital statistics; 8 9 regulating the disposition of dead bodies; limiting the disclosure of records; prescribing the sufficiency of vital 10 statistics records as evidence; prescribing fees and 11 penalties; and revising and consolidating the laws relating 12 thereto," in birth registration, providing for certain 13 information prohibited related to birth registration. 14 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 16 hereby enacts as follows: 17 Section 1. The act of June 29, 1953 (P.L.304, No.66), known as the Vital Statistics Law of 1953, is amended by adding a 18 19 section to read: 20 Section 404. Birth Registration: Certain Information 21 Prohibited. -- (a) No certificate or registration of birth filed 22 under this act after the effective date of this section may
- 23 identify the child's sex.

- 1 (b) The prohibition under subsection (a) shall not apply to
- 2 any form or data related to a child's birth that is submitted or
- 3 <u>compiled pursuant to Federal law or regulation.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
