AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), entitled "An act establishing a system of 2 unemployment compensation to be administered by the 3 Department of Labor and Industry and its existing and newly created agencies with personnel (with certain exceptions) 4 5 selected on a civil service basis; requiring employers to 6 keep records and make reports, and certain employers to pay contributions based on payrolls to provide moneys for the 8 payment of compensation to certain unemployed persons; 9 providing procedure and administrative details for the 10 determination, payment and collection of such contributions 11 12 and the payment of such compensation; providing for cooperation with the Federal Government and its agencies; 13 creating certain special funds in the custody of the State 14 Treasurer; and prescribing penalties," in compensation, 15 providing for receipt of personal identification number. 16 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 18 hereby enacts as follows: 19 Section 1. The act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937) 20 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment Compensation Law, is 21 amended by adding a section to read: 22 Section 401.1. Receipt of Personal Identification Number .--
- 23 (a) Upon receipt of an application for benefits by the

- 1 <u>department</u>, the <u>department shall provide a personal</u>
- 2 <u>identification number (PIN) to all claimants in order to access</u>
- 3 information relating to the claimant's claim on the department's
- 4 Internet claims filing system or through the PA Teleclaims
- 5 telephone system. The claimant's PIN shall be provided to the
- 6 claimant through mail and electronic mail, if applicable.
- 7 (b) The department shall create a secure method of
- 8 delivering each PIN to the claimant through electronic mail, if
- 9 applicable. The department shall transmit notice of the
- 10 completion of the secure delivery method under this subsection
- 11 to the Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the
- 12 Pennsylvania Bulletin within thirty (30) days of the effective
- 13 <u>date of this section</u>.
- 14 Section 2. The addition of section 401.1 of the act shall
- 15 apply to claims filed on or after the effective date of this
- 16 section.
- 17 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 90 days.
