AN ACT

1 Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.789, No.285), entitled, as
2 amended, "An act relating to insurance; establishing an
3 insurance department; and amending, revising, and
4 consolidating the law relating to the licensing,
5 qualification, regulation, examination, suspension, and
6 dissolution of insurance companies, Lloyds associations,
7 reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and certain
8 societies and orders, the examination and regulation of fire
9 insurance rating bureaus, and the licensing and regulation of
10 insurance agents and brokers; the service of legal process
11 upon foreign insurance companies, associations or exchanges;
12 providing penalties, and repealing existing laws," in
13 insurance producers, further providing for imposition of
14 additional fees.

15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
16 hereby enacts as follows:

17 Section 1. Section 674-A(b) of the act of May 17, 1921
18 (P.L.789, No.285), known as The Insurance Department Act of
19 1921, added December 6, 2002 (P.L.1183, No.147), is amended to
20 read:

21 Section 674-A. Imposition of additional fees.

22 * * *

23 (b) Application fee.--Notwithstanding other provisions of
24 this section, no insurance producer shall charge a fee for the

1 completion of an application for a contract of insurance, unless
2 there is no commission paid for that noncommercial application.

3 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
