AN ACT

- Designating the future bridge on that portion of Pennsylvania Route 88 over Peters Creek, Finleyville Borough, Washington
- 3 County, as the John Emerick Memorial Bridge.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. John Emerick Memorial Bridge.
- 7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (1) Sergeant John Emerick, a native of Mount Pleasant,
- 10 Westmoreland County, enlisted in the Army Air Corps in 1940.
- 11 (2) Following the 1941 attack on Pearl Harbor, Sergeant
- 12 Emerick was deployed to the Bataan Peninsula, Philippines,
- initially serving in the 19th Air Base Squadron and later
- 14 transferring to the 31st infantry unit in an attempt to halt
- 15 the Japanese advance in the region.
- 16 (3) With limited food, water and supplies, and following
- 17 the order of his commander, Sergeant Emerick, along with

- 1 approximately 12,000 Americans and 63,000 Filipinos,
- 2 surrendered to Japanese forces as prisoners of war and were
- 3 forced to march 65 miles through the jungle with no food or
- 4 water. This march would later be known as the Bataan Death
- 5 March.
- 6 (4) Sergeant Emerick survived the death march and 42
- 7 months of capture and was rescued on September 12, 1945, when
- 8 United States Forces liberated the prisoners of war.
- 9 (5) Sergeant Emerick was awarded the Bronze Star with
- 10 "V" for valor for heroism during combat operations on April
- 11 6, 1942, on Bataan. His medals included three Bronze Stars, a
- 12 Purple Heart, three Presidential Unit Citations and a
- 13 Prisoner of War medal.
- 14 (6) Following his return to the United States, Sergeant
- 15 Emerick became a commander in the American Defenders of
- Bataan and Corregidor, where he was able to assist former
- 17 prisoners of war in any way he could, including work that led
- 18 to a study resulting in legislation that would become the
- 19 former Prisoners of War Benefits Act of 1981.
- 20 (7) Sergeant Emerick was a 50-year member of the
- 21 American Legion Post in Finleyville and member of the St.
- Francis Assisi Church until his death on September 22, 2009.
- 23 (b) Designation. -- The bridge to be constructed on
- 24 Pennsylvania Route 88 over Peters Creek in Finleyville Borough,
- 25 Washington County, is designated the John Emerick Memorial
- 26 Bridge.
- 27 (c) Signs. -- The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 28 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 29 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 30 Section 2. Notice.

- 1 The Secretary of Transportation shall publish a notice in the
- 2 Pennsylvania Bulletin within 60 days of the completion of the
- 3 bridge constructed on Pennsylvania Route 88 over Peters Creek in
- 4 Finleyville Borough, Washington County.
- 5 Section 3. Effective date.
- 6 This act shall take effect as follows:
- 7 (1) The following shall take effect in 60 days:
- 8 (i) This section.
- 9 (ii) Section 2.
- 10 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect 60 days
- 11 after publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin of the notice
- 12 under section 2.
