1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, providing for contributions for the prevention of child abuse and neglect.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
7	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
8	§ 1324. Contributions for the prevention of child abuse and
9	<pre>neglect.</pre>
10	(a) General rule Within one year of the effective date of
11	this section, the department shall provide for all of the
12	<pre>following:</pre>
13	(1) Ability of a person renewing a driver's license or
14	identification card electronically through the department's
15	publicly accessible Internet website to make a contribution
16	of \$5 to the Children's Trust Fund.
17	(2) Ability of a person renewing a vehicle registration

- 2 Internet website to make a contribution of \$5 to the
- 3 Children's Trust Fund.
- 4 (b) Implementation.--
- 5 (1) A contribution under subsection (a) shall be added,
- as appropriate, to the regular fee for:
- 7 <u>(i) a renewal of a driver's license or</u>
- 8 <u>identification card; and</u>
- 9 <u>(ii) a renewal of a vehicle registration.</u>
- 10 (2) One contribution under subsection (a) may be made
- 11 <u>for:</u>
- 12 (i) each renewal of a driver's license or
- 13 <u>identification card; and</u>
- 14 <u>(ii) each renewal of a vehicle registration.</u>
- 15 <u>(c) Use.--Contributions made under subsection (a) shall be</u>
- 16 <u>used by the Children's Trust Fund Board exclusively for the</u>
- 17 prevention of child abuse and neglect.
- 18 (d) Deposits. -- The department shall determine annually the
- 19 total amount designated under this section and shall report the
- 20 amount to the State Treasurer who shall transfer the amount from
- 21 the Motor License Fund to the Children's Trust Fund.
- 22 (e) Information. -- The department shall provide adequate
- 23 information concerning the contribution for the prevention of
- 24 child abuse and neglect in its instructions for the applicants
- 25 described in subsection (a). The information concerning the
- 26 contribution shall include the address of the Children's Trust
- 27 Fund to which contributions may be sent by individuals wishing
- 28 to make additional contributions.
- 29 (f) Reporting.--The Children's Trust Fund Board shall
- 30 include in its annual report required under section 5(6) of the

- 1 <u>act of December 15, 1988 (P.L.1235, No.151), known as the</u>
- 2 Children's Trust Fund Act, the amount received from the
- 3 contributions authorized by this section and how the funds were
- 4 used.
- 5 (g) Reimbursement. -- The Children's Trust Fund shall
- 6 <u>reimburse the Motor License Fund for the actual costs incurred</u>
- 7 by the department in the administration of this section.
- 8 (h) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 9 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 10 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Children's Trust Fund." The fund created under section 8 of
- 12 the Children's Trust Fund Act.
- 13 "Children's Trust Fund Board." The board created under
- 14 <u>section 4 of the Children's Trust Fund Act.</u>
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 180 days.
