1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in licensing of drivers, further providing for issuance and content of driver's license.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 1510 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
8	§ 1510. Issuance and content of driver's license.

10	(a.2) Volunteer firefighter's driver's license
11	designation
12	(1) Beginning as soon as practicable, but no later than
13	18 months following the effective date of this subsection,
14	the department shall issue a driver's license or
15	identification card that clearly indicates that the person is
16	a volunteer firefighter. A qualified applicant is an
17	individual who currently serves as a member of a volunteer

1	fire company as defined in 35 Pa.C.S. § 7802 (relating to
2	definitions).
3	(2) Upon receipt of an application from a qualified
4	applicant accompanied by documentation required by the
5	department, the department shall independently validate the
6	documentation and immediately issue to the individual a
7	driver's license or identification card displaying a
8	volunteer firefighter designation. There shall be no fee for
9	the designation, but the qualified applicant must pay any
10	renewal or duplicate driver's license or identification card
11	fees.
12	(3) A person who falsely claims to be a volunteer
13	firefighter on an application for a driver's license or
14	identification card is subject to the penalty under 18
15	Pa.C.S. § 4904(b) (relating to unsworn falsification to
16	<u>authorities).</u>

18	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
