AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled 1 "An act relating to the finances of the State government; 2 providing for cancer control, prevention and research, for 3 ambulatory surgical center data collection, for the Joint 4 Underwriting Association, for entertainment business 5 financial management firms, for private dam financial 6 assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes; providing for 7 the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes, 8 bonus, and all other accounts due the Commonwealth, the 9 10 collection and recovery of fees and other money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 11 including escheated property and the proceeds of its sale, 12 the custody and disbursement or other disposition of funds 13 and securities belonging to or in the possession of the 14 15 Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and appeals to the 16 courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth and 17 18 all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting 19 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 20 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 21 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes 22 23 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 24 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of 25 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every 26 27 department, board, commission, and officer of the State government, every political subdivision of the State, and 28 29 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or 30 31 collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 32 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 33 every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the 34

Commonwealth," in general budget implementation, further 1 providing for Motor License Fund. 2 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 5 Section 1. Section 1798.2-E of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, is amended to read: 6 Section 1798.2-E. Motor License Fund. 7 8 [An appropriation from the Motor License Fund to the Pennsylvania State Police is restricted as follows: 9 (1) For fiscal year 2017-2018, the total amount of the 10 11 appropriation shall not exceed the total amount appropriated 12 for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017. 13 (2) For fiscal year 2018-2019, the total amount of the 14 appropriation shall not exceed 96% of the total amount 15 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017. (3) For fiscal year 2019-2020, the total amount of the 16 17 appropriation shall not exceed 92% of the total amount appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017. 18 19 (4) For fiscal year 2020-2021, the total amount of the 20 appropriation shall not exceed 88% of the total amount 21 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017. 22 (5) For fiscal year 2021-2022, the total amount of the 23 appropriation shall not exceed 84% of the total amount 24 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017. 25 For fiscal year 2022-2023, the total amount of the (6) 26 appropriation shall not exceed 80% of the total amount 27 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017. (7) For fiscal year 2023-2024, the total amount of the 28 appropriation shall not exceed 76% of the total amount 29 30 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017. (8) For fiscal year 2024-2025, the total amount of the 31

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1 appropriation shall not exceed 72% of the total amount appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017. 2 For fiscal year 2025-2026, the total amount of the 3 (9) appropriation shall not exceed 68% of the total amount 4 appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017. 5 For fiscal year 2026-2027, the total amount of the 6 (10)7 appropriation shall not exceed 64% of the total amount appropriated for the same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017. 8 9 (11) For fiscal year 2027-2028 and each fiscal year thereafter, the total amount of the appropriation shall not 10 exceed the greater of: 11 12 (i) \$500,000,000; or 13 (ii) 60% of the total amount appropriated for the 14 same purpose in fiscal year 2016-2017.] 15 The total amount of appropriations from the Motor License 16 Fund to the Pennsylvania State Police in a fiscal year may not exceed a base amount equal to the total amount of the same or 17 18 similar appropriations from the prior fiscal year, as adjusted 19 by the change in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) for the United States, for all items as 20 published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of 21 Labor Statistics, for the previous 12-month period. For fiscal 22 23 year 2022-2023, the total amount appropriated from the Motor 24 License Fund to the Pennsylvania State Police may not exceed \$300,000,000, and that amount shall be the base amount for the 25 26 calculation in fiscal year 2023-2024. The Secretary of Budget 27 shall calculate annually the adjustment under this section and transmit the information as a notice to the Legislative 28 29 Reference Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2022 or 20220HB2495PN2946 - 3 -
