- Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 2 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 3 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain 7 employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," in personal income tax, further providing for 10 classes of income. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. - 3 which is quaranteed under section 7(a) of the Small Business Act_
- 4 (Public Law 85 536, 15 U.S.C. § 636(a)) and issued to assist
- 5 with maintaining payroll costs during the period beginning after
- 6 February 29, 2020, and ending before July 1, 2020, by an
- 7 <u>authorized lender. The amount of forgiveness under this clause</u>
- 8 must not exceed the amount approved by the authorized lender
- 9 <u>that issued the loan.</u>
