## AN ACT

"Personal computer" 18 19 includes any electronic book reader, laptop, desktop, handheld, 20 tablet or tower computer, but does not include cellular 21 telephones, video game consoles, digital media receivers or devices that are not primarily designed to process data. For 22 23 purposes of this clause, "personal computer accessories" 24 includes keyboards, mice or mouse devices, personal digital assistants, monitors, other peripheral devices, modems, routers\_ 25 26 or nonrecreational software, regardless of whether or not the accessories are used in association with a personal computer\_ 27 base unit. "Personal computer accessories" does not include\_ 28 29 furniture or systems, devices, software or peripherals designed or intended primarily for recreational use. For purposes of this 30
