- from State and local taxation and making an appropriation,"
- in State lottery, further providing for powers and duties of

- 11 Section 1. Section 303(a)(11)(iv) of the act of August 26,
- 12 1971 (P.L.351, No.91), known as the State Lottery Law, is
- 13 amended to read:
- 14 Section 303. Powers and duties of secretary.
- 15 (a) Powers and duties enumerated. -- In addition to the powers
- 16 and duties provided by law and the act of April 9, 1929
- 17 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929, the
- 18 secretary shall have the power and it shall be his duty to
- 19 operate and administer the lottery, and to promulgate rules and
- 20 regulations governing the establishment and operation thereof,

including, but not limited to: 1 2 3 (11) The apportionment of the total revenues accruing from the sale of lottery tickets or shares and from all other 4 5 sources among: 6 7 (iv) for property tax relief and free or reduced 8 fare transit service for the elderly as provided in section 311. The following apply: 9 10 (A) For fiscal years beginning before July 1, 2014, no less than 27% of the total revenues accruing 11 12 from the sale of lottery tickets or shares shall be 13 dedicated to this subparagraph. 14 (B) For fiscal years beginning after June 30, 2014, and ending June 30, 2019, no less than 25% of 15 the total revenues accruing from the sale of lottery 16 17 tickets or shares shall be dedicated to this 18 subparagraph. 19 (C) For fiscal years beginning after June 30, 20 2019, and ending June 30, [2024] 2029, no less than 21 20% of the total revenues accruing from the sale of 22 lottery tickets or shares shall be dedicated to this 23 subparagraph. 24 (D) For fiscal years beginning after June 30, 25 [2024] 2029, no less than 25% of the total revenues 26 accruing from the sale of lottery tickets or shares shall be dedicated to this subparagraph. 27
