AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
- Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions, further providing for snow and ice dislodged or falling from moving vehicle.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3720 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3720. Snow and ice [dislodged or falling from moving
- 9 vehicle].
- 10 (a) Duty to remove. -- A driver of a motor vehicle has an
- 11 <u>affirmative duty to remove accumulated snow or ice from the</u>
- 12 motor vehicle prior to operating the motor vehicle. A driver who
- 13 operates a motor vehicle where accumulated snow or ice on the
- 14 motor vehicle may reasonably pose a threat to persons or
- 15 property shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$25 nor
- 16 more than \$75 for each offense, regardless of whether any snow
- 17 <u>or ice is dislodged from the vehicle.</u>
- 18 <u>(b) Dislodged or fallen snow or ice.--</u>When snow or ice is

- 1 dislodged or falls from a moving vehicle and strikes another
- 2 vehicle or pedestrian causing death or serious bodily injury,
- 3 the operator of the vehicle from which the snow or ice is
- 4 dislodged or falls shall be subject to a fine of not less than
- 5 \$200 nor more than [\$1,000] \$1,500 for each offense.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
