17	<u>§ 2401. Definitions.</u>					
18	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter					
19	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the					

1	context clearly indicates otherwise:					
2	"Affected area." A high-consequence area as defined in 49					
3	CFR § 192.903 (relating to what definitions apply to this					
4	<pre>subpart?).</pre>					
5	"Commission." The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.					
6	"Fund." The Pipeline Impact Fund established in section 2403					
7	(relating to fund).					
8	"Impact pipeline." A pipeline which is a transmission and					
9	gathering line for oil or natural gas.					
10	"Natural gas." A fossil fuel consisting of a mixture of					
11	hydrocarbon gases, primarily methane, and possibly including					
12	ethane, propane, butane, pentane, carbon dioxide, oxygen,					
13	nitrogen and hydrogen sulfide and other gas species. The term					
14	includes natural gas from oil fields known as associated gas or					
15	casing head gas, natural gas fields known as nonassociated gas,					
16	coal beds, shale beds and other formations. The term does not					
17	include coal bed methane.					
18	<u>§ 2402. Administration.</u>					
19	(a) DutiesThe commission has the following duties to					
20	implement this chapter:					
21	(1) Collect and deposit money under section 2404(a)(1)					
22	and (b) (relating to fee).					
23	(2) Carry out section 2403(d) (relating to fund).					
24	(b) PowersThe commission shall promulgate regulations to					
25	implement this chapter.					
26	<u>§ 2403. Fund.</u>					
27	(a) EstablishmentThe Pipeline Impact Fund is established					
28	as a separate fund in the State Treasury.					
29	(b) SourcesThe following are the sources of the fund:					
30	(1) Fees under section 2404(a)(1) (relating to fee).					

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1	This paragraph includes interest for late payment.
2	(2) Appropriations.
3	(3) Return on money in the fund.
4	(c) NonlapseThe money in the fund is continuously
5	appropriated to the fund. This appropriation shall not lapse at
6	the end of a fiscal year.
7	(d) UtilizationThe commission shall use the fund as
8	<u>follows:</u>
9	(1) Each year, up to 10% of the money in the fund may be
10	used for administration.
11	(2) Fifty percent of the money which is not used under
12	paragraph (1) shall be used to make an annual payment to each
13	county where an affected area is located.
14	(3) The remainder of the money which is not used under
15	paragraphs (1) and (2) shall be used to make an annual
16	payment to each municipality, other than a county, where an
17	affected area is located.
18	<u>§ 2404. Fee.</u>
19	<u>(a) Imposition</u>
20	(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2), an operator
21	that utilizes an impact pipeline shall pay to the commission
22	<u>a fee based on acreage of linear feet plus right-of-way width</u>
23	using the county average land value in an affected area.
24	(2) The fee under paragraph (1) shall not be imposed
25	upon an impact pipeline in existence on the effective date of
26	this paragraph.
27	(b) DepositThe commission shall deposit the money
28	collected under section 2403(b)(1) (relating to fund).
29	Section 2. This act shall take effect as follows:
30	(1) The following provisions shall take effect
