## AN ACT

1 2 3 4	Amending Title 27 (Environmental Resources) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for the prohibition of balloon releases; imposing duties on the Department of Environmental Protection; and imposing penalties.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 27 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a chapter to read:

13	3302. Definitions.

17	<u>3306. Departmental duties.</u>

1	<u>§ 3301. Scope of chapter.</u>
2	This chapter prohibits the intentional release of one or more
3	balloons in this Commonwealth.
4	<u>§ 3302. Definitions.</u>
5	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
6	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
7	context clearly indicates otherwise:
8	"Authorized authority." An enforcement unit, officer or
9	official of a county, municipality or other political
10	subdivision that has been granted the authority to enforce the
11	provisions of this chapter by the department.
12	"Balloon." A nonporous bag of tough and light material,
13	including latex or Mylar, which is filled or unfilled.
14	"Department." The Department of Environmental Protection of
15	the Commonwealth.
16	"Mass balloon release." An event during which a person
17	intentionally releases or causes to be released 10 or more
18	balloons into the atmosphere.
19	"Person." The term includes:
20	(1) An individual who is over 13 years of age.
21	(2) A corporation, partnership, association, nonprofit
22	entity and the Commonwealth or a political subdivision of the
23	Commonwealth.
24	"Radio tracking device." An instrument that emits a signal
25	that allows the operator to determine the position of a released
26	balloon.
27	<u>§ 3303. Balloon releases prohibited.</u>
28	A person may not do any of the following:
29	(1) Knowingly and intentionally release or cause to be
30	released a balloon into the atmosphere.

1	(2) Organize or participate in a mass balloon release.
2	<u>§ 3304. Exceptions.</u>
3	This chapter does not apply to any of the following:
4	(1) A balloon released for scientific or meteorological
5	purposes in accordance with the following:
6	(i) Released by or on behalf of the Federal or State
7	<u>Government.</u>
8	(ii) Released in accordance with a contract with the
9	Federal or State Government.
10	(iii) Released by an institution of higher education
11	conducting research.
12	(2) A balloon that meets all of the following criteria:
13	(i) Is attached to a radio tracking device.
14	(ii) Is released by a person who holds an amateur
15	operator license issued by the Federal Communication
16	<u>Commission.</u>
17	(3) A hot air balloon that is recovered after launch.
18	(4) The negligent or unintentional release of a balloon.
19	<u>§ 3305. Penalties.</u>
20	(a) ViolationsA person who violates the provisions of
21	this chapter shall:
22	(1) For a violation of section 3303(1) (relating to
23	balloon releases prohibited), be subject to the following:
24	(i) For an individual, the penalty shall be to
25	perform six hours of community service, or watch an
26	educational video on the environmental damage caused by
27	human pollution, or both.
28	(ii) For an entity, the penalty shall be a civil
29	<u>penalty of up to \$100.</u>
30	(2) For a violation of section 3303(2), be subject to a

1	civil penalty of up to \$100 for each violation.
2	(b) Number of violationsEach act of releasing or
3	organizing the release of a balloon or group of balloons shall
4	<u>be a separate offense.</u>
5	<u>§ 3306. Departmental duties.</u>
6	(a) EnforcementThe department shall enforce the
7	provisions of this chapter and may delegate the authority
8	granted under this chapter to an authorized entity. An
9	authorized entity shall report each violation to the department.
10	(b) Educational videoThe department shall select, procure
11	or develop an educational video in accordance with section
12	3305(a)(1)(i) (relating to penalties). This video may not exceed
13	<u>one hour in duration.</u>
14	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
