AN ACT Amending Title 45 (Legal Notices) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, providing for electronic publication 2 of legal notices. 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. - 3 § 401. Scope of chapter.
- 4 This chapter relates to electronic legal advertising.
- 5 § 402. Definitions.
- 6 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 7 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 8 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 9 <u>"Electronic publication" or "electronically publish." The</u>
- 10 public advertisement of a legal notice in HyperText Markup
- 11 Language format (HTML) or an equivalent language format on an
- 12 official government Internet website.
- 13 "Notice website." An Internet website that is maintained by
- 14 a government unit, or by a third party under contract with the
- 15 unit, that contains links to the legal notices electronically
- 16 <u>published by the government unit.</u>
- 17 "Official Internet website" or "official website." The
- 18 Internet location designated by a government unit as its primary
- 19 source of information about the government unit on the Internet.
- 20 § 403. Electronic advertising.
- 21 Whenever a government unit is required by law to publish a
- 22 legal notice in one or more newspapers of general circulation,
- 23 the government unit or its representative may publish the notice
- 24 on an official government notice website instead of in a
- 25 <u>newspaper of general circulation</u>, if all of the following
- 26 requirements are met:
- 27 <u>(1) The government unit, or the host of the notice</u>
- 28 website, enters into a service-level agreement with an
- 29 <u>Internet service provider that guarantees the website is</u>
- 30 accessible to the public over the Internet at least 98% of

- 1 the time, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
- 2 (2) The government unit's official Internet website
- 3 containing the notice website is registered with the Office
- 4 <u>of Information Technology of the Office of Administration</u>,
- 5 <u>for posting on a State Internet website that lists Internet</u>
- 6 <u>websites of government units.</u>
- 7 (3) The government unit's official Internet website
- 8 prominently displays a link to the notice web page, which is
- 9 <u>an index web page, containing a list of all current legal</u>
- 10 notices of the unit, with links to the full text of those
- 11 <u>notices, not just to summaries of those notices. The index</u>
- 12 <u>web page must also contain a search function and other</u>
- 13 <u>features that improve public accessibility to legal notices.</u>
- 14 (4) Each web page on the official website with a link to
- the notice web page or index web page, as well as the notice
- 16 website itself, contains an e-mail link to submit a complaint
- 17 to the government unit if access to a legal notice fails.
- 18 § 404. Complaints and service accessibility failures.
- 19 A government unit shall review all complaints reported under
- 20 section 403(4) (relating to electronic advertising) or otherwise
- 21 to determine the cause of any service accessibility failure, and
- 22 it shall document the findings and any action taken to resolve
- 23 the failure. The government unit shall keep and make available
- 24 for public inspection all records of complaints and service
- 25 accessibility failures.
- 26 § 405. Copies of legal notices.
- 27 Whenever an individual is unable to access an electronic
- 28 publication of a legal notice, the issuing government unit shall
- 29 provide a copy of the notice to the individual free of charge.
- 30 § 406. Time for posting.

- 1 Notices shall remain available on a notice website at least
- 2 <u>until the last posting date required by law has expired or until</u>
- 3 the event described in a notice has taken place, whichever is
- 4 later.
- 5 § 407. Responsible official.
- 6 A government unit shall designate an official to be
- 7 <u>responsible for electronic publication and shall post the name</u>
- 8 and contact information of the official on the government unit's
- 9 notice website.
- 10 § 408. Creation of proof of publication.
- 11 The government unit shall implement and keep or have provided
- 12 by the notice website contractor a proof of publication for each
- 13 <u>legal notice</u>. The proof of publication shall state that the
- 14 legal notice was posted from the initial date through either the
- 15 last posting date required by law or the date when the event
- 16 <u>described in a notice takes place</u>, whichever occurs later.
- 17 § 409. Proof of publication.
- 18 Proof of publication of an electronically published legal
- 19 notice for the purpose of complying with public notice
- 20 requirements shall be satisfied and deemed conclusive upon the
- 21 provision of a copy of the proof of publication, certified by
- 22 the official designated under section 407 (relating to
- 23 responsible official), stating that the notice was posted from
- 24 the initial date until the last posting date required by law.
- 25 § 410. Construction.
- Nothing in this chapter shall be construed to negate or
- 27 <u>effect any requirement in law, regulation or rule requiring that</u>
- 28 a notice or other advertisement be published in a periodical
- 29 designated by the rules of court of a county for the publication
- 30 of legal notices.

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
