1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for issuance and reissuance of registration plates.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 1331(a), (d) and (e) of Title 75 of the
7	Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the section
8	is amended by adding subsections to read:
9	§ 1331. Issuance and reissuance of registration plates.
10	(a) Department to provide platesRegistration plates shall
11	be provided by the department[.] and digital registration plates
12	may be provided by a vendor of digital license plate hardware
13	and services to motor vehicle owners that is approved by the
14	<u>department.</u>
15	(a.1) Digital registration platesA vehicle owner may
16	display a digital registration plate in lieu of the plate issued
17	under this subchapter if the registration number and
18	<u>"Pennsylvania" are clearly visible at a distance of 100 feet in</u>

1 normal sunlight.

3 (d) Reflectorizing material on plate.--All registration
4 plates, except temporary <u>and digital</u> plates, shall be treated
5 with reflectorizing material in accordance with standards
6 approved by the department.

7 (e) Issuance of plates by agents.--

8 <u>(1)</u> The department may deliver registration plates, 9 other than special plates, to designated agents, who shall 10 have the authority to issue them in conjunction with the 11 issuance of temporary registration cards.

12 (2) The department may authorize designated agents to
 13 issue digital registration plates in conjunction with the
 14 issuance of temporary registration cards and to perform other

15 <u>services, including, but not limited to, registration</u>

16 <u>services</u>, safety and telematics and visual personalization.

18 (g) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "digital 19 registration plate" means an electronic display that:

20 (1) Is mounted on a vehicle in the place of, and that
 21 serves the function of, a registration plate issued by the
 22 department.

23 (2) Displays digital messages, including, but not
 24 limited to, emergency service alerts, personalized messaging,

25 public safety alerts and stolen car alerts, if permitted by

26 <u>the department.</u>

27 (3) Has other functionality made possible by the use of
 28 digital technology.

29 Section 2. Any data collected by the department or by an 30 agent or vendor selected by the department through the use of

digital registration plates is the property of the department.
 Any use of data collected through the use of a digital
 registration plate is nonexclusive and is governed by title.
 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
