AN ACT
Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for issuance and reissuance of registration plates.
The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section $1331(a)$, (d) and (e) of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the section is amended by adding subsections to read: § 1331. Issuance and reissuance of registration plates.
(a) Department to provide plates.--Registration plates shall 11 be provided by the department[.] and digital registration plates 12 may be provided by a vendor of digital license plate hardware 13 and services to motor vehicle owners that is approved by the 14 department.

(d) Reflectorizing material on plate.--All registration plates, except temporary and digital plates, shall be treated with reflectorizing material in accordance with standards approved by the department.
(e) Issuance of plates by agents.--
(1) The department may deliver registration plates, other than special plates, to designated agents, who shall have the authority to issue them in conjunction with the issuance of temporary registration cards. (2) The department may authorize designated agents to issue digital registration plates in conjunction with the issuance of temporary registration cards and to perform other services, including, but not limited to, registration services, safety and telematics and visual personalization. * * *
(g) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "digital registration plate" means an electronic display that:
(1) Is mounted on a vehicle in the place of, and that serves the function of, a registration plate issued by the department.
(2) Displays digital messages, including, but not limited to, emergency service alerts, personalized messaging, public safety alerts and stolen car alerts, if permitted by the department.
(3) Has other functionality made possible by the use of digital technology.

Section 2. Any data collected by the department or by an agent or vendor selected by the department through the use of
digital registration plates is the property of the department.
2 Any use of data collected through the use of a digital registration plate is nonexclusive and is governed by title. 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 120 days.
