- "College." Any of the following: 17
- (1) An institution created prior to, on or after the 18

2	(i) Article XIX-A of the act of March 10, 1949
3	(P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949.
4	(ii) The act of August 24, 1963 (P.L.1132, No.484),
5	known as the Community College Act of 1963.
6	(2) An independent institution of higher education that
7	is an institution of higher education located in this
8	Commonwealth and incorporated or chartered by the
9	Commonwealth, entitled to:
10	(i) confer degrees under 24 Pa.C.S. § 6505 (relating

12	(ii) apply to itself the designation "college,"
13	"university" or "seminary" as provided for by standards
14	and qualifications prescribed by the State Board of

- 16 "Place of worship." In the buildings of or on the grounds of
- 17 a church, synagogue, mosque or other regularly established place
- 18 of meeting of a religious institution or religious organization.
- 19 "Professional sports facility." A stadium, arena or other
- 20 place owned or leased by a professional sports organization at
- 21 which a professional athletic event is conducted in the presence
- 22 of individuals who pay admission to view the event.

- 30 (19) The defendant committed the killing on the premises

- of an elementary or secondary school, college, place of
- worship, professional sports facility or government office.

- 4 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
