AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in school health services, providing for portable airway clearance devices.

 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 1426. Portable Airway Clearance Devices.--(a)</u>
- 13 Beginning with the school year 2022-2023 and each school year
- 14 thereafter, each school entity shall provide at least one
- 15 portable airway clearance device in the school entity's
- 16 <u>cafeteria and in the office of the school nurse. Each device</u>
- 17 shall be placed in an unlocked and easily accessible location
- 18 <u>during the school day and any other time a school sponsored</u>
- 19 event is taking place. The location of each device shall have an
- 20 appropriate identifying sign.

- 1 (b) Each school entity shall develop a policy for the use of
- 2 <u>a portable airway clearance device which shall include a</u>
- 3 requirement that each professional employe employed by the
- 4 school entity receive training in airway management and in the
- 5 <u>removal of an obstruction from the airway using a portable</u>
- 6 <u>airway clearance device. The policy shall be made available on</u>
- 7 the school entity's publicly accessible Internet website.
- 8 (c) A school entity may seek Federal funding or other
- 9 sources of funding to comply with the requirements of this
- 10 section.
- 11 (d) Within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this
- 12 <u>section</u>, the Department of Education in consultation with the
- 13 <u>Department of Health shall provide technical assistance</u>,
- 14 <u>resources and publish information on the Department of</u>
- 15 Education's publicly accessible Internet website regarding the
- 16 <u>use of a portable airway clearance device by a professional</u>
- 17 employe, including:
- 18 (1) Proper use of a device.
- 19 (2) Recognition of the signs and symptoms of choking.
- 20 (3) Requirements for proper access and storage of a portable
- 21 airway clearance device.
- 22 (4) Notification of appropriate persons following use of a
- 23 portable airway clearance device.
- (e) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 25 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection unless
- 26 the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 27 <u>"Portable airway clearance device" or "device" means a</u>
- 28 portable medical device that uses manually created suction to
- 29 remove a blockage from the airway during a choking emergency and
- 30 has been classified as a Class II non-powered suction apparatus

- 1 <u>device under 21 CFR 878.4683 (relating to non-powered suction</u>
- 2 apparatus device intended for negative pressure wound therapy).
- 3 "Professional employe" means as defined in section 1101(1).
- 4 "School entity" means a school district, intermediate unit,
- 5 area career and technical school, charter school, cyber charter
- 6 <u>school or regional charter school.</u>
- 7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
